CALADERM Cream – Powder

Composition:

Caladerm Cream: Contains (w/w):

- Calamine 12.5%
- Dermatol 2.5%
- Zinc Oxide 8%

Caladerm Powder

Contains (w/w): Calamine 12.5%

- Dermatol 2.5%
- Zinc Oxide 10%.
- Starch 5%.
- Talc q.s up to 100%.

Classification:

Smoothing Agent.

Indications:

Soothing protective, astringent, mild antiseptic, lubricant, for irritation mild burns (sun burns), eczema, & psoriasis.

Contraindications:

Hypersensitivity to any of the ingredients.

Precautions And Special Concerns:

1. Use in Pregnancy and Breastfeeding: Problems in humans have not been documented although its better to consult your doctor first.
2. The preparations should not be applied to raw surfaces or mucous membranes; avoid contact to the eyes.
3. Avoid inhalation of the powder.
4. If a burning sensation or a rash develops, or if the condition persists, treatment should be discontinued.

Side Effects:

Irritation may occur in hypersensitive patients.

Directions for use:

Apply to the affected areas as required.

Storage:

- Store in a dry place below 25C.
- Keep out of the reach of children.

Presentation:

- **Caladerm Cream:** Tube of 30 grams.
- **Caladerm Powder:** Plastic container of 75 and 100 grams.
